

Request for Proposals

RENTAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM: FAMILIES – ESTEVAN

Saskatchewan Housing Corporation's (SHC) Rental Development Program is designed to increase the supply of affordable housing in Saskatchewan. The program is funded by the provincial government through the SHC, an agency of Social Services, and by the federal government through Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) under the Affordable Housing Initiative.

Capital assistance is currently available for the **development of a minimum of four (4) and up to six (6) rental units for low- to moderate-income families in Estevan, SK**. These units may be new construction or conversion of existing non-residential buildings. Those interested are encouraged to form partnerships and examine innovative funding options to maximize the number of units that can be developed, encourage skills development in the construction trades and training centres, and ensure the long-term sustainability of proposed projects.

As a first step in accessing the program, non-profit corporations, co-operatives, Aboriginal organizations and the private sector are invited to submit a full proposal.

Proposals should be submitted using the Rental Development Program application form.

An information session on the application process will be held at City Hall in Estevan at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 29, 2012.
