Residential Rehabilitation Assistance Program (RRAP) for Persons with Disabilities (Homeowners)

KNOW THE FACTS

The Disability RRAP Program:

- Provides financial assistance to low-income households to complete modifications required to accommodate the needs of a household member with a disability

Disability RRAP Offers:

- Maximum forgivable loan of \$16,000 in southern Saskatchewan and \$19,000 in northern Saskatchewan

Eligibility:

To meet eligibility criteria, you must:

- have a gross annual household income below the Household Income Limits (HILs)
- occupy the property as your principal residence for more than six months of the year
- maintain legal ownership of the property

Eligible Modifications:

- Housing-related modifications that address the disability needs of a member of the household
- A doctor's certificate is required to confirm the nature of the disability and the modifications necessary to accommodate it
- Repairs completed prior to receiving written approval from Saskatchewan Housing Corporation do not qualify
